Frostfree Nosepumps Ltd. now offers a choice of piston cylinder size. Originally this livestock watering device, which operates year round without the need for power for heat or pumping, was introduced with a 3" piston cylinder, which has an outer diameter of 4". Because this posed a problem for some producers with a small diameter casing, a smaller cylinder has been developed. This new 2" piston cylinder, which has an O.D. of 2³/₄", will enable producers with a 4" or larger cased well to install the Frostfree Nosepump. Another application for the smaller diameter cylinder is that it will allow livestock to lift water from a greater depth, since the smaller volume of water from the smaller cylinder will be an easier lift. This will, however, lower the number of cattle recommended to water from one pump. The larger cylinder easily waters 100 head in winter months and 50 pairs in summer months. With the smaller cylinder those numbers should be reduced. The 4 applications for a Frost-free Nosepump are: an existing cased well; a large diameter well; a pressurized water line; dugout. Using the pump on a dugout enables producers to water year round without chopping ice or taking the risk of losing an animal through the ice. Advanced Agri-Direct Inc. of Thorsby, Alta. is offering a new summer/winter Energy Misor model of its Concrete cattle waterer. The precast concrete hulls have a 2-bowl configuration: one bowl is heated in winter and both bowls are used in summer. The bowls are coated with epoxy to protect them against corrosion from manure and silage acids. Standard models are equipped with 110-volt heaters but can be configured to 220. The 6 models of Concrete waterers vary in capacity from 19 to 120 gallons, and can handle anywhere from 200 to 600 head of stock for pasture or feedlot settings.
