Energizers

Tru-Test introduces their new Stingray series of energizers. These are the only premium, dual-purpose energizers on the market. They can operate on a 110 volt electric plug or a 12 volt battery, plus they can be used as part of a solar system.

The energizer comes with a power cord, battery lead set, and fence lead set. It has a 5-stage light bar that shows output voltage and battery charge level, plus a 6-position pulse speed switch (including an off switch) for battery conservation and maximum operating efficiency.

Other notable features include: weather proof case, day/night sensor, key parts are repairable/replaceable, mounts on wall or clips on a fence wire. Depending on the conditions of the farm and fence, the Stingray units can cover up to 30 miles/120 acres of fence. They provide safe and effective protection for all types of livestock. The Stingray series includes three Speedrite models – 1000 (1.J), 2000 (2.J), and 3000 (3.J) – and three Stafix models – X1 (1.J), X2 (2.J), and X3 (3.J).

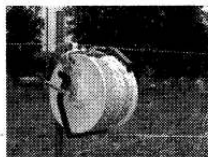

PolyBraid

PowerFlex PolyBraid is the new generation polywire. The conductive filaments, either nine strands of stainless steel or six strands of tinned copper, are tightly braided with a high quality poly product giving it double the breaking strength of twisted polywire



and superior conductivity. It is abrasion and kink resistant which contributes to a longer life span. A 1/4 mile (1320') roll fits on most standard size reels and 2640' fits on a mega reel. The 660', 880' and 1320' roll sizes come with nine strand stainless steel filaments. Beyond 1/4 mile conductivity becomes of greater concern and therefore the filaments for 2640' rolls are 6 strands of tinned copper.

Progressive graziers will appreciate the quality of this polybraid. It rolls on and off the reel smoothly. Because the filaments are protected by the braided configuration, there is far less chance of broken filaments. If a filament is broken in a twisted polywire the flow of energy stops at the break. If a filament is broken in a braided polywire the flow of energy is picked up again when other filaments are crossed. This is an unparalleled product at a very affordable price.
