NOSE PUMP — an all-weather water option

To help ranchers find safe and available water 12 months a year, Jim and Jackie Anderson have put a new spin on old-school technology: a pump that lets cattle draw their own fresh well or dugout water year-round, without the need for power.

Alberta Ag and the PFRA offer some funding these days to help ranchers bring in new water sources, so the Rimbey, Alta., ranch couple recommends that their idea, Frostfree Nosepumps, should be installed soon.

We all saw the basic idea on the folks' farm when we were kids. You pull a few times on a hand-cranked pump to draw water from the well directly beneath it. The Andersons' design, however, allows the pump to work in winter, and is easy enough for livestock to use as a drinking fountain.
